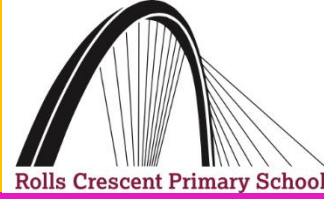

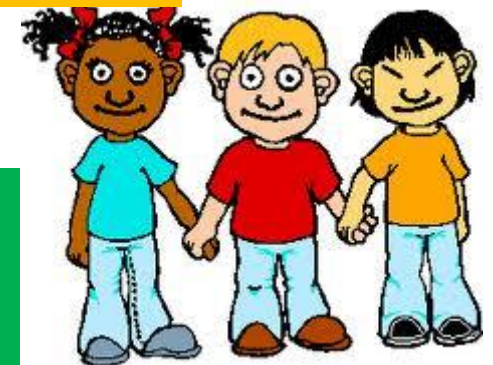

Cyber Bullying

Cyber bullying is the use of the internet and related technology to harm other people, in a deliberate, repeated and intimidating manner.

How to deal with cyber bullying

- Talk to them and be aware of any relationship changed with their friends
- Talk to your child and understand how they use the internet and their phone.
- Remind your child not to retaliate.
- Report any issues to us at School.
- Keep any evidence.

Four things..

- **Check the ratings – consider your child’s personality, maturity and abilities.**

Managing Usage

- **Set boundaries and monitor usage - be clear about what is/isn't ok!**
- **Discuss what they can share – discourage sharing personal information.**
