Activist	A person who campaigns to bring about political or social change.

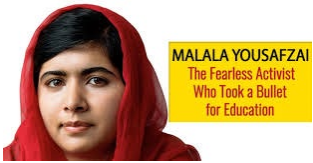
Question	Essential Knowledge
