

Year 1 Knowledge Organiser: Plants

Essential vocabulary

Blossom	A flower or a mass of flowers, especially on a tree or bush
Fruit	A flower is the bloom or blossom of a plant
Berry	A simple fruit with seeds
Seed	Seeds grow into new plants
Trunk	The main woody stem of a tree
Stalk	The main stem of a plant
Bud	A part of the plant that develops into a leaf, flower or shoot.
Branch	A part of a tree that grows out from the trunk
Bark	The outermost layer of woody plants and trees.

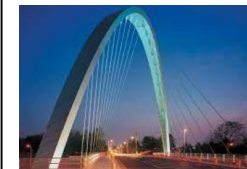
