

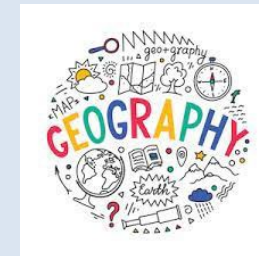
Autumn 2: Is Europe the same all over?

Border	A line separating two countries.
Inland	Land away from the coast.
Coast	The area where the sea and land meet.
Population	The number of people living in a country.
Tundra	A large, barren area with no trees. Often an area covered in ice.
Ice cap	A thick layer of snow and ice.
Grassland	A wide area of land filled with low growing plants such as grasses and wildflowers.
Plain	A flat area of land

What is a continent?	A large solid area of land that includes a group of different countries. There are 7 continents on Earth.
Name 6 countries in Europe and their capital cities.	Italy- Rome France- Paris Greece- Athens Malta - Valletta Norway- Oslo Romania- Bucharest
What is latitude?	The distance North and South of the Equator measured in degrees.
Why is the climate different in different parts of Europe?	The countries further North will get colder and countries further South and closer to the equator are warmer.
What are the major mountains and rivers in Europe?	Mount Elbrus- Russia Mont Blanc- France Galdhopiggen- Norway Seine River Danube River Rhine River
