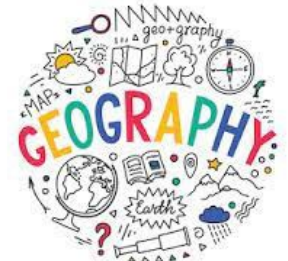

Autumn 2: Where are the significant mountains and rivers in Europe?

Essential Vocabulary	
valley	A long depression, or ditch, in Earth's surface and usually lies between ranges of hills or mountains.
cliff	Tall, steep rocks that were created by erosion and have vertical faces.
ridge	Part of the steep, sloping side of a mountain.
plateau	An area of flat ground that is much higher than the surrounding area.
mountain range	A series of mountains connected together.
source	The start of a river
summit	The highest point of a mountain.
estuary	Where a river meets the sea
stream	A natural flow of water that is smaller than a river.

	Essential Knowledge
What is the highest Mountain in Europe?	Mount Elbrus which is in Russia and is 5642m high.
What is the longest river in Europe?	The longest river in Europe is the River Danube.
What is the largest mountain range in Europe?	The largest mountain range in Europe is the Alps.
What mountain range lies between France and Spain?	The mountain range that lies between France and Spain is the Pyrenees.
What mountain range lies between Poland and Slovakia?	The mountain range that lies between Poland and Slovakia is the Tatras.
When is a mountain a mountain?	Hills become Mountains when they are over 3000ft or 914m tall.
