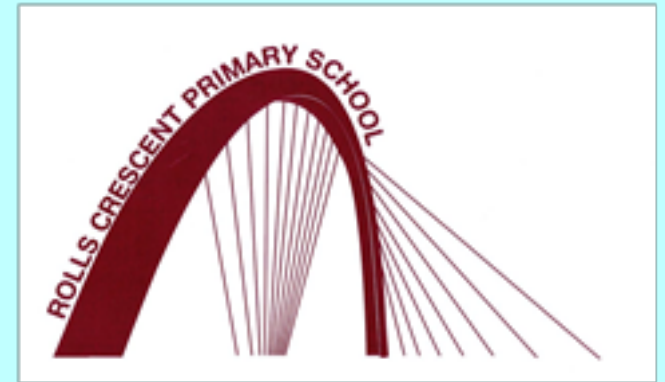

School Routines

MORNINGSSchool gates open at 8:30 a.m. and are locked 9am.

Children enter school at 9:00am

Late arrivals should enter the building via the main office at the front of the school.

Any children in the playground should be supervised by their parents or guardians until a member of staff arrives.

Formal

Formal assessments (previous SATS tests) will occur three times a year in October, December and February for Grammar, Reading and Maths Writing will be assessed continuously
