

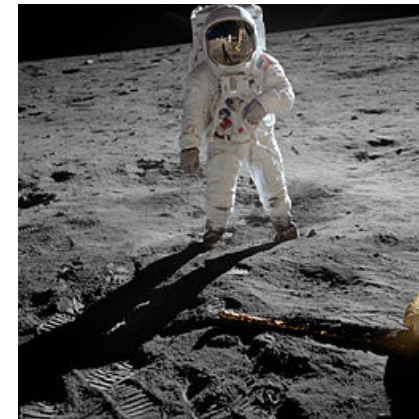
# Year 1 Knowledge Mat: Could we live on another planet?

<b>astronaut</b>	A person who is trained to travel in a spacecraft.
<b>planet</b>	A large object that orbits a star.
<b>Moon</b>	The Earth's natural satellite
<b>Earth</b>	The planet that we live on. 3 <sup>rd</sup> in order from the Sun.
<b>Sun</b>	The star that is found at the centre of the Solar System.
<b>past</b>	Before the present time. Something that has already happened.
<b>timeline</b>	Showing important events in which they occurred.
<b>rocket</b>	A vehicle that travels to space.

## Facts

Neil Armstrong was the first man to walk on the moon in 1969.
He flew in the Apollo 11 spacecraft along with Buzz Aldrin and Michael Collins.
Neil Armstrong was born in Ohio in 1930.
He could fly a plane before he could drive a car.
The Moon is Earth's only natural satellite.
The Moon orbits earth every 27 days.
