We will have our annual World Book Assembly where staff will read to our pupils, we will have a vocabulary parade and we will announce winners of our competitions.

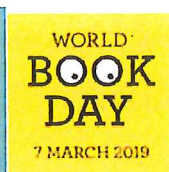
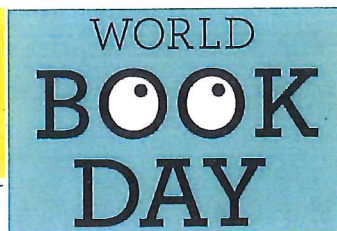
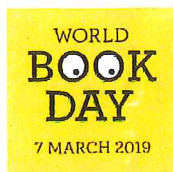
