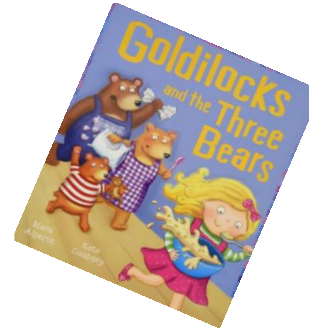


# Nursery Newsletter
