
sung as a whole school. One of the activities that they took part in was to do research on how people have celebrated jubilee's over history and create a collage to demonstrate how


people did this. Additionally, the children year 3 worked in teams to create their own model of Buckingham Palace out of Lego. They really enjoyed this activity and made some amazing models.
